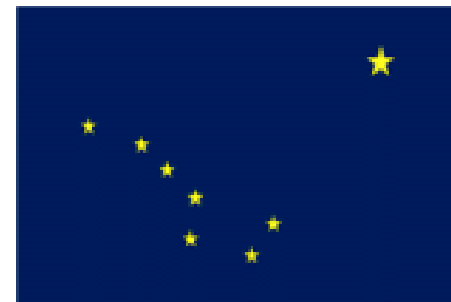

The Commission for Environmental Cooperation (CEC) facilitates effective cooperation and public participation to conserve, protect, and enhance the North American environment in support of sustainable development for the benefit of present and future generations.

CEC's Environmental Justice and Climate Resilience Grant Program (EJ4Climate) funds projects that target underserved and vulnerable communities, and Indigenous communities, in Canada, Mexico, and the United States, to prepare them for climate-related impacts. This program provides funding directly to community-based organizations to help them develop community-driven solutions to adapt to the impacts of climate change.

For this grant cycle, the CEC is calling for project proposals that will integrate community-led environmental education in support of environmental justice and community resilience to climate-related impacts.

Supported projects should meet the following criteria:

- support community resilience to climate change and climate-related impacts;
- benefit underserved and vulnerable communities, and/or Indigenous communities, and ensure the meaningful participation of local residents;
